Probate typically begins once a will is located and submitted to the court. If there is no will, the court appoints an administrator who acts on behalf of the estate. From there, the executor gathers financial documents, secures property, pays outstanding obligations, and works with the court to distribute the remaining assets. Even in uncomplicated situations, this can take months. In more complex cases, probate may stretch to a year or longer.

Many families don't realize how much responsibility falls on the executor, nor how many decisions must be made early on — especially regarding real estate. A vacant home must be maintained, insured, and protected. Utilities must stay active. Documents must be organized. And eventually, a decision must be made: keep the home, transfer it, or sell it.
